WHAT Tinted aerosol powders absorb excess oil to create instant fullness, dry cleanse, extend the life of a blow dry and provide a matte texture that keeps pins and clips from slipping so styles stay put.

WHEN AND WHY It's ideal for not-so-clean hair, styling fine hair and quick root touch-ups. Use it on dry, second- or third-day hair.



When in doubt, go with the lighter shade.



White Use if hair is white to champagne blonde and everything in between.



A Bit Blondish Use if hair is dark blonde to light brown and everything in between.



A Tint of Brown Use for shades of medium brown to darkest brown.



Soft Black Use for inky black hair – the darkest of the dark.

Stylist Tips

- Protect clothes and bath and bed linens while spraying (spots can be easily removed with soap and water).
- Section dry hair at the scalp.
- Hold can 10-12 inches away from head for a natural color result. (The closer to the head, the darker the color will be.)
- Spray in short, even strokes, concentrating on oily spots.
- Let dry, then brush out excess (do not use fingers) and style.
